Mary J. Shariff is an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Law, University of Manitoba. Mary currently teaches Bioethics and Law and Contract Law in the JD program and Legal Research and Theory in the Masters of Law program. She is a Research Affiliate of the Centre on Aging and the Desautels Centre for Private Enterprise and the Law, both at the University of Manitoba. Her principal area of research is bioethics and law, and her work includes research related to palliative care, aging and death as well as the environment and animals. Her research on end of life has been published in the McGill Journal of Law and Health, Health Law in Canada and the Canadian Medical Association Journal. She is co-author of the 4th edition of the book, *Canadian Medical Law: An Introduction for Physicians, Nurses and Other Health Care Professionals* (published in December 2013). Mary acted as an expert witness on comparative laws in the Canadian physician assisted death case, *Carter vs Canada* (Attorney General).
