There is much to celebrate as we begin 2017! During the month of December, a number of enhancements have been made inside the columbarium to further enrich the overall experience within. These include both physical and spiritual enrichments.

The physical features include a faux niche finish on the peripheral walls that visually captures the essence of the completed columbarium. Later this month, the family chapel names will be added above the doorways of the three reserved chapels.

The columbarium is now adorned with elegant 7 day vigil candle holders. The candles, which are accompanied by a small picture



frame bearing the photo of a beloved deceased, can be reserved on a weekly or annual basis, and lit in memory of a friend or family member entombed or memorialized in the columbarium.

The flame, burning brightly through the beautiful blue glass, holds vigil for the deceased and reminds us that Christ is the true light within the darkness of our grief.

Also new to the columbarium are floral vases for our niche doors.



These enable families to commemorate special days and anniversaries within the life of the deceased. The beautifully crafted vases are attached to the niche doors bearing the names of the deceased, and filled with a small floral arrangement on the requested dates. Flowers can be reserved for 4, 8 or 12 different dates throughout the year.

In the weeks ahead, I will be introducing a new monthly publication specific to the columbarium. The newsletter will keep you abreast of upcoming presentations, special celebrations, presentations and other initiatives flowing through the columbarium and its ministry. The publication will also feature bereavement

resources, informational articles and testimonials from those whose beloved deceased are entombed and memorialized within this special community. The first volume will be released for the month of February.

I look forward to collaborating with Fr. Darrin and the various ministry members who will support the continued growth and development of the columbarium's ministry through the lens of our parish mission. Light in Our Darkness

7 Day Vigil Candles at Living Waters Columbarium

The practice of lighting candles has its origins in the custom of burning lights at the tombs of the martyrs in the catacombs. The lights burned as a sign of solidarity with Christians still on earth. Because the lights continually burned as a silent vigil, they became known as vigil lights.

Living Waters Columbarium is pleased to introduce vigil candles in memory of the beloved deceased entombed or memorialized in the columbarium. The candles burn for 7 days, holding vigil for our beloved deceased.

In the lighting of candles, our prayers become symbols of the One Light of Christ. They rise up to Heaven day and night, in the presence of our beloved deceased, whom we know and love in mystery.

Each vigil candle is accompanied by a photo of the deceased for whom it is lit. Candles can be ordered one week at a time or for an entire year.

A portion of the proceeds from the vigil candle sales are directed to the Living Waters Columbarium *Legacy Fund* to support apostolic efforts in our local community and throughout the world.
